# Open the Settings Menu

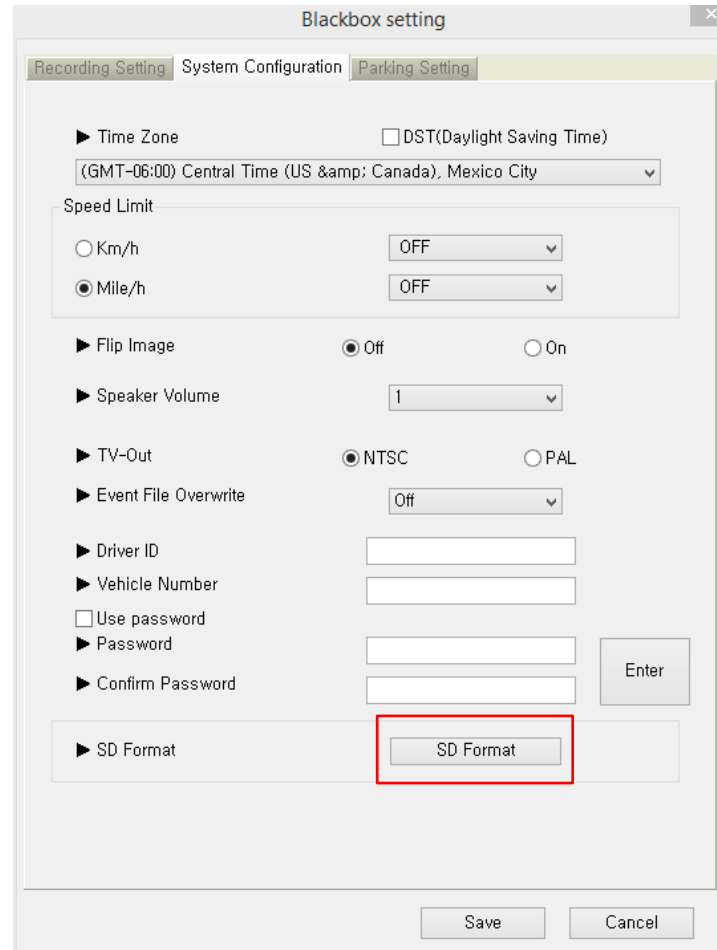
1. Click on the gear icon to open the Settings Menu.

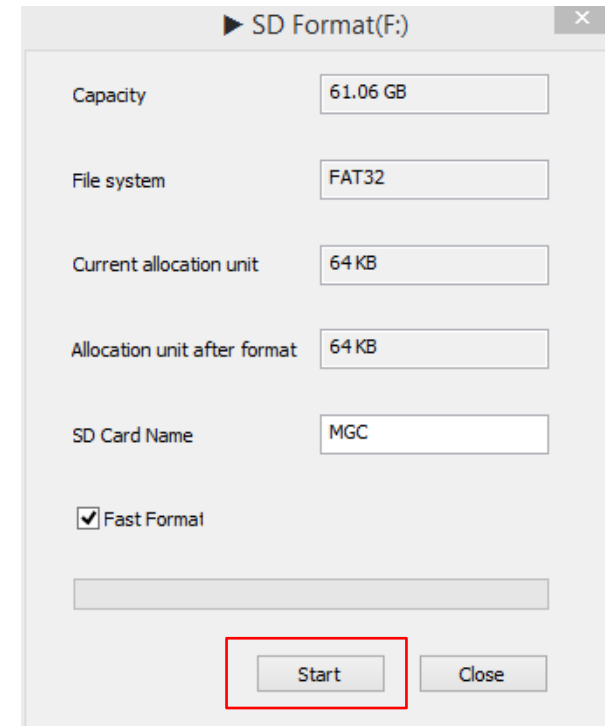
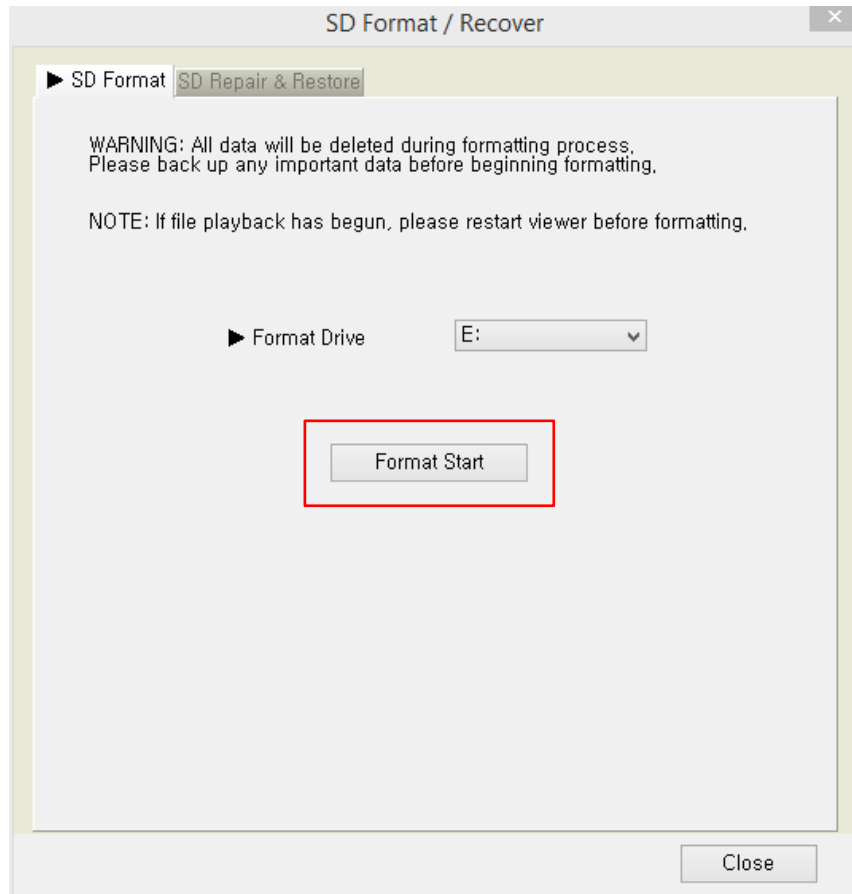
## Open the SD Card Format Menu
